Egypt – 3200 BCE





School Teacher and Author – Spain Motivation; to carry less books

- Content and Publishers
 - 1987 1st hypertext book "afternoon, a story" by Michael Joyce
 - 1993 1st company selling ebooks (BiblioBytes)
 - 1993 "Host" by Peter James published 2 floppy discs

First mass-market ebook


Stephen King's Riding the Bullet novella is released in March 2000 by Simon & Schuster, and available for download in pdf format at \$2.50. The huge demand in the first hours is causing the servers to jam. Readers have to wait for hours for the file to download.



2010

First author to sell one million ebooks

In July 2010, Hachette Book Group reveals that **James Patterson** has sold 1,141,273 ebooks, becoming the first author to cross the one million mark. At that time no third-party monitoring of ebook sales was available, so Hachette used its own sales figures and checked other top authors.



2010 Paranormal Romance

In just a few months, a 26-year-old author Amanda Hocking earned \$2 million from her self-published

ebooks

After being rejected by publishers, a young paranormal romance writer Amanda Hocking looked into self-publishing. In April 2010, she started publishing her novels for Kindle.

In less than a year she sold over 900 thousand copies of her nine novels, with 450 thousand in January 2011 alone.

3. Steps to Self Publish

Tools, Tools and more Tools

- Craft content in word document
- Use Publish Tool
- Upload created document
- Cover design, graphics, artwork
 - Professional, consider tapping into sties such as fiveer.com.
 - Test different cover designs with family and friends.



- ISBN not required for eBook
- Set Price guidelines are provided
- BINGO within 24 to 72 hours you are Published on Amazon

4. How Much \$ Do Authors Make?

There were more high-earning self-publishing authors than Big 5 authors at every single publishing "age".

Whether an author debuted in the last century, the last decade, or the last 3-5 years, they were more likely to have a higher income as an indie.

Approx 4 printed books sell for every eBook US 2022 research
